

Workers on the eight-hour shift, on the other hand, showed a marked superiority in health, in general appearance, and in efficiency. The committee reported: The proportion of physically unfit increases with the length of the hours of work. A later investigation was made covering the relation of output to hours of work. Various groups of workers were watched over a period of 27 weeks, during which time their hours of work were lowered. In the case of 100 women who were turning fuse bodies, which is fairly heavy work, a reduction in the average hours worked per week of from 68. 2 to 59. 7 was followed by a 23 per cent increase in hourly rate and an 8 per cent increase of weekly output. While this reduction of working hours to 60 a week proved so successful in increasing output, a further decrease showed that an equally large output could be maintained in 56 hours or even less. No other than the change in hours was made in the working conditions. Every care was taken to eliminate any other influence which might tend to speed up the workers. A small group of boys employed at sizing base plugs were reduced from 68. 3 hours a week to 57 hours. Their hourly rate was immediately increased by 42 per cent and their weekly output increased 19 per cent. A...
