




## The Boxcar Children 42: The Mystery of the Missing Cat

Her first novel was so popular, she would write another 18, each based in a new setting, and having a mystery for the Boxcar Children to solve, often involving eccentric characters. Mrs. Warner of Putnam CT died in 1979.
