




Non-Alinged Movement (Unipolar World and Beyond)

Non-Alignment was an anxious appeal to the nations of the world for a retreat to peace and sanity, The Movement envisioned a radical restructuring of the principles and perceptions of international Relations and policies. The initiative came in the 1950s from three nations -India, Yugoslavia and Egypt respectively represented by the three statesmen -Nehru, Tito and Nasser. From its modest beginnings at the Belgrade Conference in 1961, with a participation of 25 nations, the Non-Aligned Movement has expanded to include 114 nations in the Kuala Lumpur Summit Conference in 2003.
